## RECOMMENDED BEACHES

Shuswap Lake provides some of the best beaches in the region for houseboat moorage overnight! All major beaches are portrayed on the map; please reference the map for area restrictions and beaches that prohibit overnight houseboat mooring.

### SICAMOUS → CINNEMOUSUN NARROWS

*West side of the lake:*

- Hermit Bay
- Tillis Beach
- Aline Hill
- Cinnemousun Narrows South (watch for signs prohibiting overnight beaching)

*East side of the lake:*

- Hungry Cove
- Marble Point – watch for signs
- Shuswap Lake East

### SEYMOUR ARM

*West side:*

- Woods Landing South
- Woods Landing
- Encounter Point
- Two-Mile Creek
- Albas Falls
- Fowler Point

*East side:*

- Nielson Beach (NOT RECOMMENDED TO FAMILIES)
- Cottonwood Beach
- Wright Creek
- Bughouse Bay - (Accessible May & June during high water) Not recommended otherwise

### ANSTEY ARM

*West Side:*

- Anstey View
- Twin Bays
- Rendezvous Picnic Site
- Anstey Arm West

*East Side:*

- Roberts Bay (South end shallow in summer months)
- Four-Mile Creek
- Anstey Beach (Accessible May & June during high water) Not recommended otherwise

### SHUSWAP LAKE ARM

- Horseshoe Bay

### SALMON ARM

- Paradise Point

### MARA LAKE

*Houseboats travelling to Mara Lake **MUST CONTACT** Twin Anchors prior to entering Sicamous Channel! Larger boats (CC5 & CC6) must be piloted by Twin Anchors crew through the bridge. Please refer to operator's manual for instructions to cross the channel!*

*West side:*

- Some beaches between cabin sites

Be respectful of the Shuswap Lake environment and other areas you explore by leaving the area CLEANER than when you arrived... including the bottom of the lake! Thank you for continuing to make sure that Shuswap Lake will remain accessible for everyone!
