# MARA LAKE

#### Must contact Twin Anchors prior to entering Sicamous Channel!

Larger boats must be piloted by Twin Anchors crew through the bridge. Refer to operator's manual for instruction to cross the channel.

East Side of the Lake

- > Hungry Cove
- > Marble Point (watch for signs)
- Shuswap Lake East

- Wright Creek
- Bughouse Bay
  - (only accessible May/June, during high water)

#### East Side of the Lake

- Roberts Bay (south end is shallow in summer)
- Four-Mile Creek
- Anstey Beach
  - (only accessible May/June, during high water)
